## Neiman Marcus chooses architecture firm for Hudson Yards store

Department store chain Neiman Marcus has revealed that its first New York store will be designed by firm Janson Goldstein.

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The three-level store at Hudson Yards is being overseen by the same team that has created spaces for the likes of LVMH, Saks Fifth Avenue, Holt Renfrew and Salvatore Ferragamo, among others. Choosing a New York-based firm for this project may help Neiman Marcus translate its style to the Manhattan market.

### Anticipated opening

Last September, Neiman Marcus announced plans to open its first Manhattan location in 2018.

Neiman Marcus Group currently manages New York retailer Bergdorf Goodman, but does not have its eponymous department store within city limits. This new addition to Neiman Marcus' retail portfolio will introduce New York consumers to the Dallas-based retailer during a time that many retailers have planned expansions ([see story](#)).

The Neiman Marcus will be the anchor in the one million square foot development Shops and Restaurants at Hudson Yards. This location will allow consumers to shop the retailer's luxury fashion offerings with the views of the public plaza.
