Van Cleef & Arpels pairs with fashion design for Dover Street Market exclusive

French jeweler Van Cleef & Arpels was selected by Gaspard Yurkievich to accessorize three dresses he designed exclusively for Dover Street Market.



Paris-based Mr. Yurkievich has designed three styles of sheer dresses, available in either black or white, which will be sold at Dover Street Market's four locations in Tokyo's Ginza neighborhood, London, New York and Singapore. A number of luxury brands, across categories, have turned to Dover Street Market to retail limited-edition collections and products, as the retailer's concept attracts a savvy clientele.

Perfect pair

The three dresses designed by Mr. Yurkievich can be worn as separate pieces or layered together. When worn in layers, the transparency of the sheer material is heightened.

On numerous occasions, the French designer has explored the relationship between jewelry and apparel.

For his most recent project, Mr. Yurkievich tapped long-time friend and fellow French brand Van Cleef & Arpels to present two new creations alongside his three dresses. Doing so expresses the "interplay" of jewelry and dress.

At each Dover Street Market, Mr. Yurkievich's dresses will be displayed on a mannequin that also wears Van Cleef & Arpels' new Vintage Alhambra creations. Inspired by the clover, Van Cleef & Arpels first debuted the Alhambra design in 1968.

The Van Cleef & Arpels' pieces are also featured in black-and-white portraits taken by French artist Valerie Belin and commissioned by Mr. Yurkievich for the project.

Mr. Yurkievich and Van Cleef & Arpels' pairing will be available at Dover Street Market Ginza Nov. 22 through Jan. 11 and in London, New York and Shanghai Nov. 30 to Dec. 22.
