Glenmorangie plans for future via distillery expansion

LVMH-owned Scotch whisky maker Glenmorangie has announced plans to expand its historic distillery as it gears up to celebrate its 175th anniversary.



Still distilling

Located in Tain, Scotland, the Glenmorangie distillery expansion plans will see the scotch brand create a new still house.

By building a new still house, Glenmorangie will be able to increase its capacity to meet rising global demand.

Glenmorangie's new production site will include two more of the scotch brand's signature copper stills, the tallest in Scotland. The still house is expected to be completed by 2019 and will work in tandem to the existing distillery.
