Luxury Collection opens boutique hotel in British countryside

Marriott International's The Luxury Collection has opened its first property in the English countryside, as an 18th century mansion gets a new life as a hotel.

The Langley, A Luxury Collection Hotel, Buckinghamshire, is situated in Langley Park outside of London. With a lengthy history, this marks the first time the home is being used as a hotel.

From home to hotel

The Langley was originally built between 1756 and 1760. The third Duke of Marlborough used the mansion as a hunting lodge.

Along with the main house, the hotel includes guest and residential rooms in the adjacent brew house. In total there are 41 accommodations available, including a three-bedroom suite named after the duke.

Before opening the building as a hotel, developer Khalid Affara oversaw a six-year renovation on the structure.

"The restoration of The Langley has been an incredible process involving large teams of experts painstakingly regenerating this magnificent historic building to its former glory," Mr. Affara said in a statement. "The whole estate

is steeped in such rich history and heritage, so we are thrilled to finally open the doors to a truly unique property that successfully celebrates The Langley's past whilst offering contemporary luxury and design alongside outstanding dining and cutting-edge spa and gym facilities."

The hotel includes modern amenities such as a 17,200-square-foot spa in partnership with Sisley, including a steam room and an indoor swimming pool. Guests can also get beauty services such as manicures and pedicures and hair styling.

For its gym, The Langley teamed with fitness expert Matt Roberts to offer personal training and diagnostics.

Visitors can also take part in outdoor activities such as clay pigeon shooting, horseback riding and croquet.

Guests can also partake in afternoon tea, meals and cocktails at the property's three dining venues.

"Buckinghamshire is a picturesque county full of rolling green hills and stunning gardens, grand castles, and quaint towns with rich history," said Anthony Ingham, global brand leader of The Luxury Collection, in a statement. "The Langley is yet another stunning example of The Luxury Collection's commitment to restoring historic icons across the globe, and our guests will deeply connect with our first hotel in this remarkable destination respite just outside the buzzing city of London."

The hotel brand has undergone other historic renovations in the past.

For instance, The Luxury Collection Hotels & Resorts previously increased its footprint in the Asian market with the opening of a Singapore property in early 2017.

Housed in a restored pre-colonial complex, The Duxton Club is in partnership with boutique developers Harpreet and Satinder Garcha, and marks the first hotel to be opened by the brand in Singapore. Located in the Tanjong Pagar conservation district, and boarding the culturally-rich Chinatown, The Duxton Club is in close proximity to Singapore's epicenter of stylish leisure and dining ([see story](#)).
