Seabourn balances adventure, relaxation in world voyage

Cruise line Seabourn is going to the ends of the world with a new global voyage setting sail in 2021.

Departing from Miami in January 2021, Seabourn's Sojourn will visit 60 ports on six continents on an east-to-west trip. This also marks the first time Seabourn will offer its "Ventures by Seabourn" program on a world cruise.

Around the world

The theme of Seabourn's 2021 world cruise is "Extraordinary Oceans." The Sojourn will cross the Pacific and Indian Oceans, as well as sail along the Atlantic coast of Africa.

Among the highlights are the cruise line's first stop at Easter Island, which includes an overnight stay for optimal exploration over the course of two days.

Other stops include Tahiti; Fiji; Melbourne, Australia; the Seychelles; Cape Town, South Africa and Casablanca, Morocco. After 140 days, the Sojourn will disembark in Barcelona.

"I wanted this world cruise to be exploratory in nature, focused thematically on alluring destinations and experiences that are a blend of sought-after favorites combined with other smaller, quaint ports that are perhaps a bit unknown to some," said Tim Littley, senior director of itinerary planning at Seabourn, in a statement. "The cadence of the journey is designed to get guests into the rhythm of exploration with an equal amount of time to relax."

Guests who book the full 140-day voyage by May 31, 2020 will receive roundtrip business class air, a \$4,000 shipboard credit per suite, unlimited Internet, luggage shipping and invitations to exclusive events, among other benefits.

Travelers can also book shorter segments on the Sojourn, ranging from 21 to 81 days.

Guests on the Sojourn can also participate in Seabourn Ventures, the cruise line's new program that offers purpose-based travel to the world's most remote destinations.

Seabourn is looking to up its luxury offerings for the adventurous traveler with more immersive voyages. Wilderness experts, scientists, historians and naturalists will make up the planning and onboard teams to provide guests with the most immersive and knowledgeable trip possible ([see story](#)).
