Fendi to present Kim Jones' first couture collection next month

Italy's Fendi has revealed that British designer Kim Jones will present his first couture collection for the fashion label in January 2021.



Mr. Jones' spring/summer couture collection will debut at Palais Brongniart during Paris Haute Couture Week on Jan. 27. He is also expected to present his first ready-to-wear Fendi collection the following month in Milan.

Paris Haute Couture Week will run from Jan. 25 to Jan. 28.

This will prove to be a pivotal collection for Mr. Jones, who joined Fendi in September.

Mr. Jones will continue to retain his position as artistic director of Dior Men. He takes over from Silvia Venturini Fendi, who was temporarily in charge of womenswear after the death of Karl Lagerfeld last year.

Mr. Lagerfeld held fort at Fendi from 1967 to his death, and also doing double-duty, holding the creative reins at Chanel. Ms. Venturini Fendi, the third generation of the Fendi family in the business, will continue to create the accessories and menswear collections (see story).
