The hotel group's plans for 2021 include opening a new location in Istanbul as well as reopening locations in Madrid; Bodrum, Turkey; New York and Lago di Como, Italy. Following the appointment of Joanna Flint as chief commercial officer, Mandarin Oriental is also expanding its offerings at current properties, highlighting local partnerships and giving consumers more excursion options.

### More from Mandarin Oriental

For those interested in options in the United States, the Mandarin Oriental, New York has reopened, with 244 elegant guest rooms and suites, each with views of Manhattan. Amenities include the Mandarin Oriental lounge offering an all-day dining option overlooking Central Park and the Manhattan skyline; the five-star Mandarin Oriental spa and a state-of-the-art fitness center with a 75-foot lap pool.

The Mandarin Oriental, Washington DC has launched new excursion packages, helping tourists feel like locals.

Some offerings include museum tours, water taxi rides, shopping in Georgetown, Michelin-starred dining and more. The hotel is also partnering with Aaron Silverman of Rose's Restaurant Group, of Michelin-starred restaurants Rose's Luxury, Pineapple and Pearls and Little Pearl, for Rose's at Mandarin Oriental, offering guests a first-of-its-kind bespoke experience.

For international options, Mandarin Oriental Bosphorus, Istanbul is expected to open this summer. The hotel's design, inspired by Istanbul's waterway, aims to pay homage to the city.

The hotel is aiming to serve as a peaceful destination while still offering a city hub hotel feel. Rooms will feature organic textures and patterns with bespoke metal and leather to reflect the brand's elegance and attention to detail.

Mandarin Oriental Ritz, Madrid has reopened after completing the most extensive renovation in its 110-year history. The hotel opens with 153 luxuriously appointed rooms, including 53 suites, and will also feature five restaurants and bars.

Mandarin Oriental, Lago di Como reopened its doors last week, highlighting its new reset, relax, renew package which includes spa treatments and a private restorative well experience. The hotel also completely redid its panoramic suite, which homes an oversized terrace with a sundeck and private pool overlooking the lake.

Last year, Mandarin Oriental ran a content marketing campaign that aimed to connect virtually with consumers on lockdown through its classic hospitality, keeping ties warm with its audience in the hopes of resuming the in-person relationship once travel restrictions were lifted ([see story](#)).
