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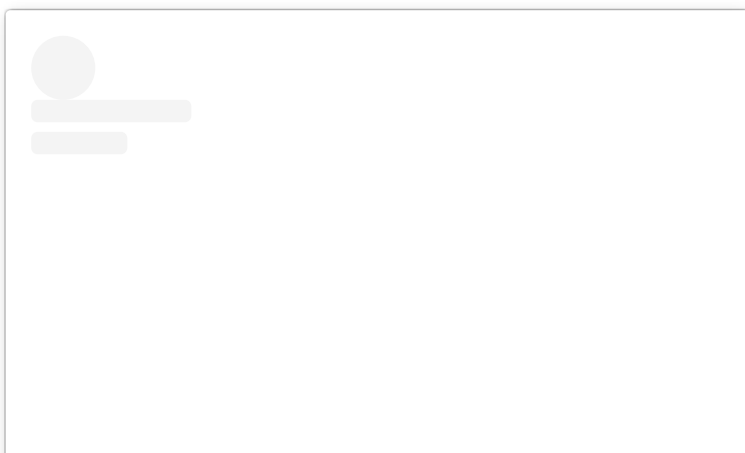
The collaboration, hinging on Louis Vuitton's women's creative director Nicolas Ghesquire's contemporary design, blends the historical with contemporary. The vibrant collection consists of a selection of Louis Vuitton products highlighting Fornasetti motifs, including buildings, locks, keys and portraits.

The collection includes a powerful combination of color and textures, utilizing traditional and cutting-edge techniques including jacquard, embroidery and laser printing.

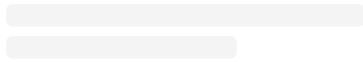
Mr. Ghesquire's contemporary approach is highlighted throughout the collection.

One highlighted collection piece is a version of the Cannes bag in transformed leather, with a Fornasetti black-and-white architectural drawing, emblematic of Renaissance-era Florence.

Another focal point of the collection is the Louis Vuitton x Fornasetti parka, which features a haute-couture embroidery technique with petal-like gold fabric that adds texture and volume to the lining. The exterior features spotlights Fornasetti ancient figures.
