## Dolce & Gabbana taps Miss Sohee for Milan Fashion Week event

Italian fashion label Dolce & Gabbana is supporting emerging talent with a new initiative.

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Dolce & Gabbana is collaborating with Korean designer Sohee Park and fashion label Miss Sohee to present her next collection at Milan Fashion Week. Her design work uses artisanal methods with an emphasis on unique shapes and volume, with aesthetic similarities to Dolce & Gabbana.

"Knowing Sohee, we had the opportunity to appreciate the authenticity and freshness of her approach, very close to ours," said Domenico Dolce and Stefano Gabbana, cofounders of Dolce & Gabbana, in a statement.

"Her dedication and love for Fatto a Mano convinced us to support this project, and we are really happy to be by her side in this special moment: the future belongs to the youth."

### Rising star

In February 2022, Dolce & Gabbana will host the next Miss Sohee presentation at one of its Milan locations, coinciding with Fashion Week. The brand intends to support the young designer across the organization.

"I am extremely grateful to Domenico and Stefano for their generous support and for this unique opportunity," Ms. Park said in a statement. "Knowing that I can count on them and that they encourage my creativity is a real honor."

Dolce & Gabbana is not the only luxury house to give a platform to a young designer at the upcoming Milan Fashion Week.

Italian fashion label Valentino is partnering with the nonprofit Camera Nazionale della Moda Italiana to feature emerging designers during Milan Fashion Week in an ongoing series.
