Maroma, the Belmond hotel in Riviera Maya, is set to reopen on May 25, 2023. The property is primed for an extensive renovation and redesign, reimagined with the goal of honoring Mexican artisanal traditions, authentic craftsmanship and interiors utilizing local materials.

Maroma will continue to serve as a renowned Mexican beach retreat, with 200 acres of dense tropical jungle and the white sands of the Caribbean coast. The property also overlooks the beach, with access to the largest barrier reef in the Western Hemisphere.

The property holds 72 rooms, suites and villas and aims to provide guests with thoughtful, restorative experiences.

The renovation and redesign are being headed by designer Tara Bernerd and her team.

Maroma's property will offer the harmony of surrounding nature, an indoor-outdoor spa and four dining options that celebrate Mexico's regional cuisines.
