The hotel, featuring 250 guestrooms including 19 suites and 16 one and two-bedroom penthouse residences, is now accepting reservations.



The New York experience

The Ritz-Carlton New York was designed with both city sights and style in mind.

The guestrooms and public spaces highlight floral expressions, with the lines and curves of the petals aiming to echo New York's verticality and city grid. Guestrooms also feature bespoke furnishings and a neutral color palette that welcome the light of the living spaces and city views.

The Ritz-Carlton Suite is located on the 37th floor, with its 2,100-square-foot space offering views of the city, a private wellness room, separate living and dining areas, media room, walk-in closet and a service entrance.

Culinary and entertainment options include Nubeluz located on the hotel's rooftop; The Lobby Lounge and Bar; The Bazaar by Jos Andrs, set to open later this year and more.

Guests staying on the Club Level will have access to the Ritz-Carlton Club Lounge where they may work, experience concierge service and have access to culinary offerings. The Ritz-Carlton Spa and Fitness Center also includes eight treatment rooms as well as separate sauna and steam rooms.

The new hotel also features 10,000 square feet of meeting space, including a private outdoor terrace, ideal for working, meeting and enjoying a luxurious city experience.

"I am honored to be leading a talented team of Ladies & Gentlemen as we open our doors to guests and locals alike in this everchanging and dynamic community," said Bastian Germer, general manager of The Ritz-Carlton New York, NoMad, in a statement.

Ritz-Carlton has several locations throughout the country.
