Alfa Romeo releases limited-edition centennial anniversary Quadrifoglio models

Italian automaker Alfa Romeo is celebrating more than 100 years of a classic car.



In honor of the milestone anniversary of its Quadrifoglio vehicle, the brand is out with newly-dropped Giulia and Stelvio variants. With only 100 units introduced per model, the release platforms a level of exclusivity true to the luxury automaker and its customer base.

Racing ahead

The Quadrifoglio debuted on April 15, 1923, winning the 14th edition of Italty's Targa Florio.

The oldest sports car race at the time, the competition brought people from around the world to Sicily in the 20th century. Alfa Romeo's victory led to heightened popularity for the vehicles, thus, the Quadrifoglio is an intrinsic part of the brand's heritage.

Alfa Romeo Giulia and Stelvio Quadrifoglio 100 Anniversario

The design of the Giulia and Stelvio models stays true to the automaker's past while outlining the company's future. The cars feature the brand's classic Quadrifoglio logo, keepsake badges and high-technological innovations.

Each unit hosts a carbon-fiber grille and mirror caps, carbon-fiber instrument panels finished in 3D, gold brake calipers and interior stitching. Additionally embellishing the interior is black leather and an embroidered "100" on the dashboard, aside a special golden version of the logo.
