Lamborghini branded residences set to arrive in Spain by 2027

Italian automaker Lamborghini is turning to the home front for its latest project.



Slated to be completed in 2027, the brand is debuting its first-ever European residences, located in Spain. The exclusive complex, called Tierra Viva, will offer affluent buyers scenic views and designs drawn specifically from Lamborghini supercars the company worked with luxury real estate developer Dar Global to achieve the feat.

"This partnership represents the merging of Lamborghini's luxury super sports car essence and Dar Global's proficiency in real estate," said Stephan Winkelmann, CEO of Automobili Lamborghini, in a statement.

"Tierra Viva embodies the core and power of Lamborghini and its unrestricted nature, interpreted into an architectural masterpiece."

Vehicular venture

Situated in Benahavis in Andalusia, the lot overlooks sweeping vistas of the Mediterranean Sea.

Fifty-three mansions are under development. The gated community will provide residences with smooth access to popular tourist sites, while also being protected by around-the-clock security.

Each home's look is informed by Lamborghini luxury vehicles in finish and design details, from the inclusion of leather to glasswork.

Valued at about 282 million euros, or roughly \$310 million, the private neighborhood presents three unique residence layouts, including the six-bedroom Diamante, five-bedroom Zafiro and the smallest model, Esmeralda, which will have four bedrooms.

Villas come with panoramic swimming pools, gardens, direct vehicle access, terraces and embellished marble flooring.
