Swiss watchmaker Omega is commemorating the anniversary of a popular model.

In homage to Seamaster, the event featured speeches concerning underwater exploration, conservation talks and discussions of the fresh range of watches, adorned with Summer Blue dials.

Timepieces sporting the specialized and exclusive hue run the gamut in price, from \$5,900 for a Diver 300M to \$14,300 for a Ploprof 1200M.

"All watches feature a unique blue, used in greater or lesser degrees to reflect the water resistance of each model," said Mr. Aeschlimann.
