Emirates teams up with Men's Cricket World Cup 2023

Dubai, U.A.E-based airline Emirates is promoting a global sporting event.

Enjoying hospitality and ticketing rights, the company is the official airline partner of the International Cricket Council (ICC) Men's Cricket World Cup 2023. The 48 matches are taking place across India from Oct. 5 to Nov. 19, 2023, and for the occasion, Emirates is allowing passengers to catch the tournament on Sport 24 and Sport 24 Extra aboard the company's flights.

Hitting a six

As a longstanding global partner of the ICC, Emirates is ringing in the 13th edition of the competition by tapping Indian wicketkeeper batsman, Dinesh Karthik, who fronts a new video from the airline.

The athlete is shown watching the matches live on one of the company's planes, revealing the inflight entertainment system that allows all to see the cricket players, who span 10 teams, participate.

This will be the first time that Mr. Karthik offers commentary at a World Cup, making the sporting event especially significant for the star.

For the collaboration, Emirates is featured on the official kits for the ICC Elite and International Panels of Umpires, the officiating body that will oversee the games.

The airline is also transporting the organization's members and referees to the events at the stadiums where the company is holding a presence and hosting on-site activities.
