Dolce & Gabbana's 'Du Coeur la Main' exhibition opens in Paris

Italian fashion house **Dolce & Gabbana** is bringing its Italian flair to the streets of Paris.

The brand's "Du Coeur la Main" retrospective spans 12 years and includes over 200 looks, 300 accessories and 230 pieces of homeware. The exhibition is on view at the Grand Palais from Jan. 10 to March 31.

Alta moda

The exhibition first debuted at the Palazzo Reale in Milan ([see story](#)), and the reimagined Paris edition highlights designers Domenico Dolce and Stefano Gabbana's passion for Italian heritage and artisanal traditions.

Alongside pieces from Dolce & Gabbana, the exhibition highlights artwork from visual artists in dialogue with the fashion house. For example, French-born, Spanish-Vietnamese artist and actress Anh Duong painted images of herself in the design duo's creations.

The design duo also pay homage to Italian filmmaker and theatre director Luchino Visconti's movie "Il Gattopardo." Every Dolce & Gabbana runway show opens with the film's theme music and clips from the movie can be seen in the exhibition.

The presentation was produced by IMG, with curation by fashion historian Florence Mller and scenography by Agence Galuchat.
