The Macallan hosts exclusive residency at Rosewood Baha Mar

Scottish whisky maker The Macallan is teaming up with hospitality group Rosewood Hotels & Resorts.

Now live, the beverage brand is hosting an exclusive residency at Rosewood Baha Mar in the Bahamas. Running through April 2026, the pop-up offers a suite of gastronomic and mixology experiences alongside limited edition releases from the luxury spirits label.

Prestige pours

Bespoke whisky tastings and five-course meal services characterize the new collaboration, set inside a transformed version of the property's Conservatory.

The Sunset Reserve Tasting will be hosted weekly, with the event promising an intimate sensorial journey for up to 16 guests set against golden hour lighting. Through the end of December, the whisky selection will include The Macallan's Harmony Collection Amber Meadow and A Night on Earth in Jerez de la Frontera, with the Harmony Collection's Vibrant Oak replacing the former next year.

Meanwhile, the space will also be home of The Five Senses Dinner, a monthly five-course dining experience which will see a

rotating roster of chefs prepare a curated menu that pairs well with The Macallan's rarest spirits. Fabio Pineda, Riccardo Bertolino, PJ Calapa, Francisco Sanabria and Daniel Boulud are among the accomplished culinarians who will take part in the initiative; a closing service will be hosted in April 2026, with a professional lead yet to be announced.

Guests can access the exclusive residency by contacting the property's concierge and reserving a seat, with prices set at \$95 per guest for The Sunset Reserve Tasting and \$375 per guest for The Five Senses Dinner.

Fellow hospitality staple Orient Express is also crossing over with another high-end operator, enlisting French beauty brand Guerlain to craft a spa aboard its upcoming sailing yacht, which will debut in June 2026 (see story).
