# Waldorf Astoria Los Cabos Pedregal finalizes large-scale renovation

Hilton's Waldorf Astoria is unveiling the next chapter for a key South American property.

Following a years-long period of construction, the resort has completed its extensive renovation. Through the project, the hotelier has refreshed all of the getaway's 112 guest accommodations and its main public areas, including its spa, central adult pool and the signature Beach Club Restaurant.

"The completion of Waldorf Astoria Los Cabos Pedregal's highly-anticipated renovation marks a significant milestone for the resort, which aims to continue on its storied legacy while deeply integrating the vibrant heritage of Mexican culture," said Juan Gonzalez, general manager of [Waldorf Astoria Los Cabos Pedregal](#), in a statement.

"The resort has created a legacy that is both authentic and modern, solidifying the property's position as the premier destination in Los Cabos for both new guests and ones who continue to return to Waldorf Astoria Los Cabos Pedregal time and time again."

## **Fun in the sun**

The refresh was overseen by Dallas-based designer Paul Duesing, with various bespoke features crafted by Mexican artisans.

Local traditions and inspirations drove the creative vision behind the project, with all rooms, suites, casitas and villas now taking on a lighter color palette, featuring neutral earth tones and warm accents. The signature Waldorf Astoria Spa also now embodies these influences, introducing a suite of new treatments based upon the four phases of the moon, alongside a renovated salon.

As a part of the Beach Club Restaurant's update, it has introduced Mar y Lea, a bespoke, Baja-inspired menu of premium, wood-grilled meats offered inside Beach Club Palapa. The venue will also host a Sunday brunch program, which features a rotating food selection, surprise weekly offerings and specialty coffees alongside live performances from local DJs.

To complete the property-wide refresh, the resort's El Farallon's Champagne Terrace will launch "Savor the Sea," a mid-day, cliffside meal service with Baja seafood and Champagne pairings. The resort's private wine label, Pedregal Collection, is introducing two exclusive vintages, a Blanc de Blancs and a Ros, for the offering.

Meanwhile, Waldorf Astoria is preparing to expand its global presence, recently signing a deal to bring its high-end hospitality to the state of Goa in India ([see story](#)).
